Ever wondered what old cities like Delhi, Mumbai and Kolkata looked like more than a hundred years ago? Both novices and seasoned collectors will find much to like from vintage photographic prints of 19th century India—a time when British photographers were fervently documenting the Indian subcontinent's historical and natural heritage. Bangalore's Tasveer art gallery and London's Bernard J Shapero Rare Books bring their travelling exhibition to Mumbai's Institute of Contemporary Indian Art. On display are images of the Elephanta Caves, Tipu Sultan's summer palace in Seringapatam and the marble palace at Delhi's Red Fort.
