CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

Tasveer seeks applications for its 2015 Internship Programme. This short term internship programme is intended for individuals interested in the visual arts, museum collections and related disciplines.

Providing technical hands-on experience, this internship will include exposure to the diverse range of responsibilities that inform the structure and functioning of an art institution.

The Internship

The intern will participate in a currently ongoing archiving project, work with the public relations portfolio and be involved in other administrative activities at the gallery.

This will provide him/her practical experience with reference to handling artefacts, an understanding of photographic documentation and detailed cataloguing processes, a broader grasp of the nature of collections, and an overview of the behind the scenes nature of work that informs an art institution's front end including curatorial and exhibition activities.

A significant segment of this internship may also include research and writing for Tasveer's projects and its allied programmes.

Terms

- The internship will be hosted at Tasveer, Bangalore and last for a period of three months. It may be extended upon review at the end of this time, if there is a mutual inclination to do so.
- The internship will require a commitment of three days each week.
- Please note that this is an unpaid internship, and that it would only be possible for the gallery to support local travel remuneration.

Eligibility

- The candidate must reside in Bangalore for the period of the internship. Outstation candidates are encouraged to apply, but must arrange for their own travel expenses to Bangalore, and accommodation for the duration of the internship.
- He/she must possess a strong command of the English language, including excellent writing and communication skills.
- An educational background or work experience in the arts is not required, but welcome. An interest in the same, would however be necessary.

How to apply

Applicants are required to email in their applications to intern@tasveerarts.com by the 12th of January 2015.

The application must include:

1. Personal Statement: Your personal statement should consist of no more than 500 words that explains your interest in the Tasveer Internship programme, and how it fits in with your background or career goals. Include your own research interests, how you believe you can contribute and describe what you hope to achieve from the experience.
2. Resume/curriculum vitae: Current resumes are required for all candidates. Please limit the length of your resume to 2 pages.
3. Writing sample: Either academic or general; both published and non-published pieces are acceptable.

Each season, it programmes six exhibitions which highlight different areas of India's rich visual culture, including fashion, fine art and heritage that travel the country, showing at its gallery spaces and partner venues in Delhi, Bangalore, Mumbai, Kolkata and Ahmedabad.
